"AN ORDINANCE TO REPLACE ORDINANCE NO. 267 AND AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 198 RELATING TO WATER CHARGES AND AMEND THE APPENDIX TO ORDINANCE NO. 159 (PART E) RELATING TO WATER SHUT-OFF AND TURN-ON FEES.

THE CITY OF HANCOCK ORDAINS:

Part B. METER CHARGE IN ADDITION TO THE SERVICE CHARGE SHALL BE:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The water rate shall be \$6.85 per one thousand (1000) gallons of metered water. However, the minimum bill shall be \$6.85 per month.
- Section 2. This rate increase will commence with the January, 2010 utility billing.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The Council has deemed it necessary to charge a flat water debt fee on the utility bill based on meter size. Charge to be determined by Council Resolution.

Part E. WATER SHUT-OFF AND TURN ON

<u>Section 4.</u> The turn-on and turn-off fee for water services will be raised to \$60.00 for turn-on and \$60.00 for turn-off.
